Lifetime Achievement Award Submission Worksheet

Purpose

The Lifetime Achievement Award recognizes significant, sustained contributions to the field of military logistics and the professional logistics community. The award is intended to honor long-term service, leadership, influence, innovation, and impact across a career of contribution to Marine Corps logistics.

Eligibility

This award is open to Active Duty, Reserve, and Retired Marines, and Department of the Navy (DON) civilian employees serving with or in support of the United States Marine Corps.

Individual nominations only. This award must be nominated by another person or organization. Self-nominations are not permitted. No command endorsement is required.

Nominees should have a demonstrated record of meaningful contribution to the profession over time. The current baseline expectation is a minimum of nine years of contribution to the military logistics field.

What This Award Recognizes

Strong Lifetime Achievement nominations highlight a sustained record of contribution, leadership, and impact across the Marine Corps logistics profession.

This award is best suited for nominations that:

- Recognize long-term contribution rather than a single accomplishment
- Show meaningful impact on the profession, an organization, or the force
- Reflect leadership, influence, innovation, or service over time
- Demonstrate why the nominee's record merits special recognition

Typical Submission Format

Nomination packages should typically be 2-4 pages in length.

Information You Should Prepare Before Using the Website Form

Please be prepared to provide:

- Nominee name
- Nominee eligibility category
- Nominee's organization, unit, command, or employer

- Nominator name and organization
- Primary point of contact
- Email and phone number
- Short nomination summary
- Main nomination package
- Any optional supporting files

Recommended Submission Content

Your nomination should clearly address the following:

- 1. What are the nominee's most significant contributions to military logistics?** Describe the accomplishments, influence, or body of work that define the nominee's impact.
- 2. How has the nominee contributed to Marine Corps logistics over time?** Explain how the nominee's service, leadership, innovation, or professional involvement has strengthened the field across a sustained period.
- 3. What impact has the nominee had on organizations, people, or the profession?** Describe the nominee's effect on readiness, logistics practice, professional development, innovation, mentorship, or institutional improvement.
- 4. What makes this record especially worthy of recognition?** Explain why the nominee stands out among peers and why the contribution is notable enough to merit a lifetime achievement award.
- 5. How has the nominee demonstrated leadership, influence, or lasting example?** Where applicable, describe how the nominee shaped others, influenced the profession, or set a standard of excellence over time.
- 6. Where appropriate, what broader relevance does the nominee's contribution hold?** If applicable, explain whether the nominee's influence also extends to the Joint Force, partners, industry, academia, or the broader defense logistics enterprise.

Strong nominations should be clear, specific, and grounded in sustained contribution rather than general praise. They should explain not only what the nominee did, but why it mattered and why it deserves recognition.

Optional Supporting Material

Nominations may include supporting material where useful, such as a short biography, supporting documentation, or other concise materials that strengthen the nomination. Supporting material should support the nomination package, not replace it.
